#### **Director's Note**

Creativity is a process. On the rare occasion, something comes together quickly and unexpectedly but mostly it is a process. Performing arts tend to be a community undertaking. The process is very often collaborative, giving space for performers and staff to work together to create something from that sense of community.

Eighteen months ago, the broad creative process for *Annie* had been completed and we were doing detail work. Making sure the lights were set properly; that cues were in place; putting final touches on costumes and make-up; making sure that everyone knew exactly where they should be onstage and off. Ticket sales had been brisk, and we were awaiting a sold-out show. We were almost there.

Then came COVID-19 and it all came to a heartrending end. We told ourselves that we would be back soon, although the fear was that this wasn't going to be a short-lived intermission. We wanted to believe with Annie that "the sun'll come out tomorrow."

We are excited that it seems "tomorrow" is almost here. We told ourselves that coming back would be easy, since most of the hard work was already done. The set was still in place; the lights were still hanging; blocking was pretty much done. Most of the cast was able to return and while the orphans were almost two years older (and taller), we could easily adapt their costumes.

Thankfully it has almost worked out that way. We have had to adapt some of our movements to protect our cast and audience from coming in close contact, so things look a bit different than they did, but the heart, the passion, the sense of fun and the joy of finally being together again is still in place.

I think the Annie of the cartoon would be pleased with our progress.

The cast and crew of this *Annie* reboot have been wonderful. The protocols we have put in place to keep everyone safe have not always been fun or comfortable, but everyone has been willing to do what is necessary to make sure the show goes on. So, for this Director's Note, just a big thank you to everyone involved. And now #PleaseReturnToYourSeats.

In the first weeks of Covid lockdown, I felt excited when various theatre companies announced on-line viewing of their past seasons. It seemed like the theatre world had landed in my living room. I viewed some Stratford productions, some Andrew Lloyd Weber musicals, and a few other professional performances, but then noted that my enthusiasm for all this had waned. Something was missing

and that something was what I'll call 'the magic' I have experienced when attending live theatre. As TryLight returns to the stage, I have been wondering about this magic. What is it? What creates it? Perhaps you know.

For me, the magic begins as I feel the pre-show energy. Words of anticipation and excitement are exchanged with ushers and with those whose feet I step over as I find my seat. 'Enjoy the show' we say to each other, knowing that we are in store for something special. TryLight is a community theatre company and it's always great to be community seated together. There is a buzz of conversation as we visit pre-show. Then, when the lights dim, we become silent together. Maybe it's just me, but at times my eyes moisten when this happens. This may seem silly but the emotion of it all just gets to me, especially when, as Board Chair, I know all the work that has led up to this moment and can envision the community who are cast and crew, in their places, ready to go. As part of a live audience, I react with everyone around me. We laugh, gasp, cry and appreciate...together. It must be something about togetherness that makes live theatre so magical. Actors, musicians and audience become one. All of us attending to a story. All of us reacting to a character. All of us responding to one another, audience to cast and cast to audience. We, the audience, respond to people from our community who now stand before us on stage. We take in the story while also feeling admiration and pride as 'that guiet man who works in a store downtown' sings from centre stage and 'that young child' puts forth at a level beyond their years. Live theatre has many things happening all at the same time. It is an experience that is alive with energy and with response. We play off each other, interact with each other, and give our hearts to each other.

I've missed live theatre and am so happy to once again experience the magic with all of you.

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
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
