#### **DIRECTOR'S NOTE**



Bruce Graham

I am very excited for the opportunity to present All is Calm to our TryLight audiences. This is an important story that needs to be told.

Christmas is a time of Hope, and I can't think of a better example to demonstrate Hope, than the Christmas truce that happened during the first year of World War I, in 1914.

Being in the trenches during World War I must have been a horrifying experience. For many of

these men, their lives had previously known only peace. Now, suddenly, they are thrust into this chaotic and terrifying existence, where the rule of survival has become — kill, or be killed. For most of these men, this would have been the darkest point in their lives, and it would be easy to understand if they had given up hope.

But then, on Christmas Day, the light of Hope glimmers. And it gives a few soldiers the courage to lay down their weapons, and present themselves to their enemies in the spirit of trust and friendship. By their example, the light of Hope burns brighter, and a few more soldiers join them. This light of Hope continues to grow and burn brighter, until we witness a true Christmas miracle.

All along the front lines, soldiers from all sides have laid down their weapons and come together in Peace. And, for a few, short hours, hostilities are forgotten. Politics and national agendas are forgotten. The men focus on the many things they have in common rather than on the few things that make them different. And, for those few short hours, the Hope of Christmas is shared by everyone. The Hope for "Peace on earth to all".

My wish is that everyone who sees this show will have their light of Hope rekindled, and that it will continue to burn and grow brighter through the Christmas season and beyond.
